RESULTS

Between 2006 - 2018, Ontario saw significant increases in the number of voters who had and took the opportunity to vote online.

In 2006, only 19 municipalities provided online voting as an option for voters. By 2018, this increased to 103 municipalities, giving 1.4 million voters a new way to actively participate in their elections.
